We have had **SEVERAL CASES** of head lice at school. Head lice are very common in elementary schools. Lice must have a human head on which to live. Lice are usually spread by head to head contact with an infested person, by sharing combs, hats, personal articles, etc. Lice can be transmitted in movie theaters and gyms. Slumber parties are a common place to spread lice, also.
